If you're one of those women thinking of going DIY for your next dye job, the Mixer may be the bridging product you need. Created by Canadian company Colour Revolution, it's a clever, no-muss root-touch-up gizmo that will make you wonder what all your fussing was about.

The secret to the Mixer's simplicity is its stylish double-barrelled design: A sort of giant syringe mixes colour and developer together as they are pushed out the nozzle and onto your hair. It's lightweight and comfortable to hold, which makes it easy to make sure the colour goes where you need it. And it comes with a handy brush/comb that lets you divide your hair, work in the product and distribute it evenly. Leave it on for half an hour, shower it off and you're good to go.
